I am emailing you to let you know **I am enthusiastic in my support of Proposition A and hope you will take a moment to find out why your vote will truly matter this June.**

Prop A is a parcel tax that goes directly to support San Francisco teachers. It requires a two-thirds majority for passage. **With a low voter turnout looming every vote counts—and we need your vote.**

All of us agree that we must work to make San Francisco a more family-friendly environment. Some of us have kids in public schools, some of us do not, but I know we all take pride in our city and in ensuring that our city offers our children ample opportunities to thrive. Each one of our children deserves to be educated in a great school.
